Mohan Baidya Panel Rejects Partnering [with] Nepal PM Bhattarai Led Regime

The Mohan Bidya Kiran panel of Unified Maoists' Party has out rightly rejected the offer of becoming a part of the present government led by their vice chairman Baburam Bhattarai.

"We are not going to join this government. We suggest Baburam Ji to tender his resignation instead," the party Chief-whip and prominent fire brand leader of Baidya panel Dev Gurung told journalists, January 11, 2011.

"We had agreed to take him along with us, but not to become a part of his government", Gurung said of Prime Minister Baburam.

Hatred against Bhattarai is on the increase.

"I do not think that the Chairman could ever collect the courage to request us join the government. Let alone we voluntarily join the government", he also said.

A definite challenge to Chairman Dahal.

"Let me tell you that majority of our Central Committee members are in favour of Bhattarai's resignation. But he is our vice chairman. We cannot force him out of the government. We expect Bhattarai ji to tender his resignation", Gurung so said.

"We have been demanding scrapping of the 4 Point deal signed with Madhesi alliance and BIPPA deal with India," also said Gurung.
