Nepal Maoist' Chief Prachanda claims he is being sidelined

The so-called ferocious Chairman of the former rebel Party, Nepal Communist Party-Unified Maoists, Pushpa Kamal Dahal aka 'Prachanda' has publicly accepted that he is being enclosed from all possible directions by his own party men.

"It is not unnatural for those who have been attacking the sovereignty of our motherland and those who have been soaking blood of the countrymen to encircle you" said Dahal and added, "It is indeed a painful moment when people whom you call your own do not understand you well", Dahal lamented while addressing a program Monday, June 28, 2010.

Prachanda also claimed that attitude of the Government and parties in government make it clear now that the war for total liberation is not yet over.

"We want to build a new Nepal in peaceful manner. But, we were wrong. We must prepare ourselves for a long drawn struggle".

Prachanda's remarks came just a day after reports revealed that vice chairmen Dr. Babu Ram Bhattarai, Mr. Mohan Baidya Kiran and General Secretary Ram Bahadur Thapa 'Badal' have joined hands against Prachanda's self-centered and highly ambitious attitude.

It was also reported that during the recently concluded Politburo meeting Prachanda was heavily criticized for his egoistic behaviors and making frequent off the cuff remarks.
