

Those immortalized in the struggle for revolution and communism commemorated in Dersim

On the occasion of the last week of January being the "week of commemoration of the martyrs of revolution and communism", martyrs are commemorated at their graves.

Partizan continues to commemorate those who lost their lives in the struggle due to the week of commemoration of the martyrs of revolution and communism in many places, leaving carnations at their graves, and reiterating the promise of struggle.

Partizan also visited the graves of 5 red carnations martyred on February 2, 2011 in Dersim, Haydar Arğal, who was immortalized with Murat Tekgöz in the clash in the countryside of Geyiksuyu-Okurlar (Askesor) village where they were on a revolutionary mission on May 6, 2016, and Hakan Çakır, who was immortalized with Cengiz İçli and Özgüç Yalçın in Ovacık Şahverdi village on October 21, 2015, and left carnations.

In these difficult times of the struggle, there were emotional moments as the lack of the missing was felt more. Carnations were also left on the grave of Sakine Cansız, the Sara of the patriotic movement, who was also murdered in France.

Her successors left the graveside with a "promise to keep her ideals alive".

The immortalized were commemorated in Izmir.

The first commemoration was held at the Balçova cemetery, at the grave of Kenan Demir, who was immortalized as a result of an armed attack by a counter-revolutionary-assassin gang while carrying out activities in Switzerland.

The commemoration started with a moment of silence and speeches were made on behalf of Partizan and by the participants. In the speech made, "This month is a month in which we send off many martyrs of revolution and communism to the sun. It is the month when Lenin, the great teacher of the world revolutionary movement, the proletariat, became immortal. It is the month when Rosa Luxemburg and Karl Liebknecht, the leaders of the German proletariat, were murdered. It is also meaningful on the occasion of the 100th anniversary of Lenin's immortalization. It must be stated that the capitalist-imperialist order has not been able to cast a shadow on the teacher and ice-breaker of socialism for 100 years. Because his successors continue to fight sacrificially to crown this teaching with revolution in many parts of the world.

Comrade Kenan Demir turned his face to the revolutionary struggle by shattering the refugeeism, the state of being good people, which is nowadays presented as a blessing to the peoples of underdeveloped countries. It is an attitude that should be taken as an example and spread."

Martyr commemorations and visits to the families of martyrs in Istanbul, Izmir and Dersim will continue in other cities in the coming days due to the "Martyrs' Week"
