On February 12, 2025, Comrade Myrna "Ka Maria" Sularte was martyred. At the age of 71, this communist revolutionary fell in battle during a fierce clash between the New People's Army (NPA) and the fascist 901st Infantry Brigade in Barangay Pianing, near the center of Butuan City.
