Afghanistan in captivity of Taliban Islamic ultrafascism

On August 15, 2021, US-Allied imperialism handed over Afghanistan to the Taliban. For the past four years, Afghanistan has been in captivity to the Taliban's Islamic ultrafascism; Experiencing the darkest days. The savage and trans-terrorist Taliban group has denied and trampled all the political and civil rights and freedoms of the Afghan people and has led the country to collapse. Women have been excluded from the economy, politics and culture and their human and civil rights have been denied. There is no longer even a trace of women's voices in any mass media. Gender apartheid and anti-feminism have cast a shadow over the country and the gates of schools and universities have been closed to young girls and women. Women are not allowed to work and are not even allowed to leave the house alone without a male so called mahram/ male accompany. Such ultrareactionary apartheid, even in the 21st century, shows that Afghanistan is captured in the clutches of the most fascist reaction. This ultrafascist reaction has suppressed all spheres of life, with the weapon (implementation of Islamic Sharia and the implementation of divine rules) has dried up any voice of resistance and cry of protest in the throats of the oppressed. The usurping terrorist group has expanded its dictatorship and black oppression by killing and imprisoning every potential opponent. Any opposition, however slight; It is considered un-Islamic and is labeled as (takfir) and opposition to the rule of Sharia. The most reactionary decisions by the Taliban leadership have been forcibly imposed by the so-called Amir al-Mu'minin or the Taliban leader (Mullah Hibatullah Akhundzada) by force of guns and sticks. The Taliban theocracy, more brutal than the Iranian mullahs' theocracy, has taken a stronghold against any revolution and against progressive demands. The Taliban ultra-fascist reaction, from a class point of view, has its roots in the ruling reactionary classes of the feudal bureaucrat comprador and the remnants of the big bourgeoisie of the comprador camp affiliated with imperialism, mainly US imperialism and slaughters the Afghan people in the most severe forms. The Taliban's hostility to the oppressed ethnic groups is far more naked, acute and brutal than the socalled "first" rule of this ultra-chauvinist group. The people of Afghanistan, just as they stood against the puppet regime of US-co imperialists, have never approved of the reactionary and ultra-fascist Islamic Taliban rule and are resisting this black reaction in various ways. In this regard, the country's revolutionary intellectuals, by defending democratic values and trying to mobilize the people, in order to overthrow the Taliban, are leading the masses to a better tomorrow. It is clear that the struggle against a puppet so

gennant regime supported by world-eating imperialism is not an easy task. That is why the freedom-seeking peoples of the country, in the light of the pioneering revolutionary leadership of the Afghanistan proletariat, will go towards the protracted people's war, the protracted Peoples War against the Taliban monsters. In this regard, the Afghanistan Workers' Organization (Marxist-Leninist-Maoist, mainly Maoist) will lead the imprisoned peoples of the country to the liberation and victory of the new revolutionary leadership by raising the red banner of the scientific ideology of the proletariat and by defending Maoism and finally by upholding and applying Maoism to the concrete reality our country. Our organization, as it stood from the very beginning against the puppet regime of the occupying imperialists, now stands against the black reaction and ultrafascist Taliban and calls on the oppressed peoples of the country to launch a protracted peoples war for the victory of the new democratic revolution.

The terrorist Taliban have taken away the breathing space of the people of Afghanistan in all areas. The wave of assassination that the Taliban have launched over the past several decades, with the usurpation of political power by this ultrafascist group, using politicalmilitary power that is not accountable to the people, is taking more victims among the youth and other groups and oppressed protesters. The Taliban's hostility to democracy and progress is endless. They do not tolerate even the smallest manifestations of progressive civic life. If in Italy under Mussolini, the fascist views of the likes of Giovanni Gentile were supported and praised by the Leader as the "most fascist reforms", now in Afghanistan, the most ultrafascist ideas and actions of the Taliban are seen by the group's leadership as the "most legitimate". Ultrafascist erformances are appreciated and praised. As the fascists began to reorganize the school system in Italy, the terrorist ultrafascist Taliban first proved their extremely reactionary nature by closing the gates of schools and universities to girls and women. They have also also closed the door to the natural sciences, with hundreds of book titles and dozens of subjects removed from the curricula of schools, universities and other educational institutions. This reorganization of the male curriculum is another step towards creating a curriculum that defends and preaches gender apartheid and supports and preaches Islamic ultrafascism of the Taliban terrorist group. There is no trace of free media in Afghanistan. Women, as mentioned above, have been excluded from all areas of activity outside the home, including working in the media. In Afghanistan today, not only is there no sign of freedom of expression, but talking about freedom of expression has been declared equivalent to disbelief to God and Islamic Sharia. The theocracy of Taliban ultrafascism considers democracy equivalent to infidelity and the Taliban explicitly call human rights (the category of infidelity and anti-Islamic). If the Italian fascists and Nazis

had declared the worship of the leader to the extent possible, the Taliban ultrafascists have given their criminal leader superhuman sanctity and declared his source of legitimacy as God's essence. Such is the state of captivity in Afghanistan today in the last four years. In Afghanistan today, all political parties and groups are banned and civil society activists are also interrogated, some of them have been killed and some are in Taliban prisons. The Taliban's hostility to the arts, especially music, is not over, and they consider music to be an evil act. Other arts have also been virtually removed from the scene. Recently, even poetry has been severely restricted and the criminal and savage leader of this group has even declared the recitation of romantic poetry against Islamic ethics and against Islamic Sharia. In such a situation, only the proletarian revolutionaries, as the most steadfast and determined revolutionaries, can lead the people against the ultrafascist Taliban regime with the slogan and demand of the victory of the new democratic revolution. The deal of the socalled "neoliberal-neoconservative" bourgeois masters with the Taliban practically gave the caricature of bourgeois democracy to the meeting of Taliban ultrafascism. The only real option the people of Afghanistan have before them is a State of New Democracy. In this regard, the protracted people's war is the path to be taken to achieve New Democracy. Our organization calls the oppressed and imprisoned peoples of the country to the hot trenches of revolutionary struggle to achieve a free, progressive, prosperous and democratic society and declares that there is no choice but to wage a new democratic revolution. And in this regard, by launching the protracted peoples war, we can stand against imperialism, feudalism, and the preachers of bureaucratic capitalism. The overthrow of the Taliban and the cutting off of the hands of the imperialist colonialists from the pure lap of our homeland is the only shining path that guarantees the triumph of the revolution. Let us rush to launch a protracted people's war for the victory of the new democratic revolution. Revolution is the only solution
